The Sublime Degree of Master Mason is often thought of as the ultimate degree of Freemasonry.

However, many Masonic scholars agree that the narrative of the Craft, as illustrated in the three degrees, is not the whole story.

In the York Rite, A Master Mason may become a member of three bodies. Actually a group of separate Rites joined in order.



These include:
Chapter of Royal Arch Masons;
Council of Royal and Select Masters;
Commandery of Knights Templar.

The Degrees of York Rite Masonry complete the story and provide answers to many questions that the newly-raised Master Mason may have. By joining the York Rite, a Master Mason may proceed to supplement and expand upon the degrees of the Blue Lodge.

THE ROYAL ARCH DEGREES fill in the spaces of the Craft (Blue Lodge) Degrees, showing how a Mason asks for his wages and rediscovering the Lost Word. The Royal Arch Degree is percieved as more august, sublime and important than those which have preceded it and is the very summit of perfection in Ancient Masonry.
